<b>Meaning</b> -ideas and information -details	My picture reminds me of my story, but my story might change as I tell it.	My story stays the same, but only some parts of my story go with my picture. <b>Style</b> -clarity and variety of language -description	I use one long sentence or lots of short sentences.	I use frame sentences that we have used in class.
